

**GREEN MEADOW POINT COMMUNITY CLUB, INC.**  
**Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations**

**I** These rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of members and their guests. They are designed to provide safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities. Operating rules and regulations are subject to changes as recommended by the Board of Directors and Pool Manager. These will be enforced by the manager and lifeguards.

**II GENERAL RULES**

1. The pool shall be used by authorized members and guests only when officially open and lifeguards are on duty.
2. Hours of pool operation:

Weekdays	10 a.m. to 8 p.m.	Tuesday and Thursday
Saturday	10 a.m. to 8 p.m.	Open until 9 p.m.
Sunday	12 noon to 8 p.m.	
3. **All children age 8 and older, who cannot swim two lengths of the pool, must be accompanied by a responsible person (age 14 and older). In order to qualify as a swimmer, a child must swim two lengths of the pool in good form and tread water for one minute – under the observation of the manager/lifeguard.**
  - A. **Must be able to swim two lengths of the pool to be in the deep end or on the diving board. If unable to do so, must be under direct supervision of responsible adult.**
4. If child is accompanied by a sitter, the sitter must register with the lifeguard and MUST SUPERVISE the children in his/her supervision. **PARENTS/SITTERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES.**
5. NO PETS OF ANY KIND WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE POOL ENCLOSURE.
6. The Corporation assumes NO responsibility for loss of or damage to personal property.
7. The lifeguards shall be certified as Senior Lifeguards in accordance with current Red Cross standards.
8. Persons having communicable diseases, sores and other skin diseases, inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharges or wearing **bandages** will be refused admission to pool.
9. **NO GLASSWARE or GLASS CONTAINERS of any kind are allowed in the pool area.**
10. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the pool area except on certain designated adult nights during which children are prohibited.
11. **THIS IS A NON-SMOKING ESTABLISHMENT!**
12. The manager and lifeguards DO NOT GUARD THE WADING POOL. **NO CHILD** over the age of **five (5)** shall be allowed in the wading pool. **If child is in diapers, we request that you use the swimmers' diapers\*!!!! There are diaper changing tables in each of the bathrooms. We request that you use these, please. (\*Coupons may be available on the bulletin board in the hall!)**
13. Order and discipline will be maintained at all times.
14. The pool manager and/or lifeguards are expected to discipline offenders and have the right to expel the offender for the day. If the offense continues - for the season. The Board will be notified of these actions.

**III GENERAL REGULATIONS**

1. Only rubber or plastic toys and/or floats will be allowed in the pool. The lifeguards may, at their discretion, request that all such objects be removed from the pool during crowded conditions.
2. All swimmers **MUST** shower before entering the pool.
3. Eating must be confined to designated areas of the concrete areas.
4. The pool area will be kept in a clean and orderly manner and lifeguards will empty trash disposal containers. The lifeguards are not private butlers, however, and **ARE NOT EXPECTED TO PICK UP AFTER MEMBERS. PLEASE POLICE YOUR AREA BEFORE YOU LEAVE THE POOL!!!**
5. There is a garbage can labeled **ALUMINUM CANS**. **PLEASE EMPTY AND CRUSH YOUR CAN AND DEPOSIT IT IN THE CORRECT GARBAGE CAN. DO NOT PUT TRASH IN THIS CAN!** The money received from the recycling of these cans is used to help defray pool expenses.
6. The pool will be kept in a clean and sanitary manner. Proper chemicals will be used.
7. Only one person may be on the diving board at a time. **NO BOUNCING ON THE BOARD!**
8. **NO DIVING IN THE SHALLOW END!**
9. A first aid kit will be available and the lifeguards will be instructed in its use.
10. The restrooms will be clean and sanitary for use by the members. **Again, make sure when you use the restroom, you leave it clean!**
11. The lifeguard stands are for the lifeguards **ONLY!**
12. The pool may be closed because of storms, low temperatures, or other circumstances. This may be done at the discretion of the pool manager.
13. The lifeguards may request membership identification of any individual in the pool area. (They have a list of all members.)
14. Adult swim periods shall be designated during times when the pool is crowded with children.
15. **Anyone using the volleyball court MUST clean sand off before entering pool area. Volleyball rules must be observed at all times. You must sign out the net and/or ball with lifeguard.**

#### IV GUEST RULES

1. Guest shall be defined in two classes: **house guest and/or local guest**. A house guest is defined as temporarily residing with the member and should live more than 40 miles away. A local guest is defined as a day guest.
2. House guests are accorded the same privileges as the member as long as they reside with the member. They should register with name of member and notify the lifeguard when entering the pool area.
3. Local guests may attend the pool with the member on a **once-a-week** basis. There will be a fee of **\$3** per guest or **\$7** per family (three or more). **The fee is for the day.**
4. **Local guests may not attend more than once a week – even when coming with different members.**
5. **No non-member resident of Green Meadow Point** may qualify as a guest except for privately scheduled parties.
6. **All guests must register when entering the pool – and fee must be paid. They must be accompanied by member.**

#### V MISCELLANEOUS RULES

1. Situations arising not covered by these rules and regulations shall be administered by the manager or the designated representative and reported to the Board of Directors for consideration.
2. Complaints and requests are to be directed to the Board and manager.
3. Changes to the rules and regulations are to be posted on the bulletin board.
4. **THE POOL MAY BE RENTED FOR PRIVATE PARTIES BY MEMBERS AT THE RATE SET BY THE BOARD.**
  - A. Parties may be held from 8 p.m. to midnight. Noise levels must be observed. Rowdy guests may be asked to leave by the lifeguards. If more than 40 guests are in attendance, additional lifeguards will be needed, at an additional \$12 per hour.
  - B. Pool rental fee is **\$35** per hour – this covers rent of the pool and two lifeguards. You may use a guest as a lifeguard upon presentation of certification. **Payment in CASH at time of party.**
  - C. Make reservations with lifeguard **at least one week ahead of time. Must be listed on calendar!**
  - D. Birthday parties for **youngsters** may be held at the pool during the day when arrangements have been made with the lifeguard **at least one week ahead of time.** (Limit of 15 guests, cost of birthday party - **\$30 + tip**, three-hour limit.) Food may be served in the picnic area and decorations are allowed. **You are asked to leave the area clean!**
5. Swim lessons are taught by pool employees with proper certification. Lessons are \$30 payable to instructor. Check bulletin board for lesson times.
6. **We ask that no boxers be showing under trunks.** Persons will be asked to pull up their trunks if they come in like this. The next time, they will be asked to go home and change into fitted trunks!

#### **CHECK THE BULLETIN BOARD PERIODICALLY FOR ANNOUNCEMENTS!!!**
